All our ceremonies can be taken as a renewal of vows or to celebrate the union of couple LGBTQ+. The attire (clothing) is left to the discretion of the couple. Our rates are inclusive of tax, for the couple.



POLYNESIAN CEREMONY Here Iti (My Ioue)

The ceremony will take place on the beach under the famous Autera'a tree also known as the "Tree of Love". Flower decoration will create a colourful and cheerful atmosphere to the venue.

Lulled by the Ukulele player, you will be welcomed by the Master of Ceremony who will then bless your union. To end the ceremony, a refreshing cocktail will be served before the farewell.

Duration: approx. 15 minutes

Location: Under the Tree of Loue*

66,500 XPF (557.27 Euros) per couple

Included:

One flower leis per person upon arrival at the venue.

One flower crown per person upon arrival at the venue.

Floral decoration at the wedding location.

Master of Ceremony.

Liue Ukulele player (30 minutes).

One wedding cocktail per person under the "Tree of loue".

In-room flower decoration upon your return.

POLYNESIAN CEREMONY Te Pae Miti (Beach Wedding)

This traditional ceremony will take you to the root of the Maohi culture. Glide over the water in the outrigger canoe to reach the venue set on the beach. Dressed up with the traditional white pareo and adorned with flower leis and crown, you will be welcomed by the priest to the rhythms of Tahitian drums. As the Polynesian songs and dances fill the air, the priest will celebrate your union and give you your Maohi name. To round up the experience, a refreshing cocktail will be served and your marriage certificate will be presented.

Duration: 20 minutes approx.

Location: Under the Tree of Loue*

109,900 XPF (920.96 Euros) per couple.

One outrigger canoe ride per person & decoration of the canoe.


POLYNESIAN CEREMONY

Te Pahi Pae Miti (Ceremony on the lagoon)

Initiate your journey on a catamaran cruise to reach the majestic Cook's Bay, where the lush mountain range drops into the crystal water. While lulled by the gentle breeze, you will be blessed by the Polynesian priest. Traditional dances and songs will give the rhythms to this unforgettable moment.

The boat will then head for a snorkelling spot where an array of colourful fish will greet you as you dive into the turquoise water. Your captain will then berth to a sand bank for lunch with "your feet in the water".

To end this memorable day, you will have the opportunity to swim with the rays before returning to the Resort.





Duration: 6 hours — Departure at 9:00 a.m. — Return at 3:00 p.m. Location: On a private boat, in Cook's Bay & on a "Motu" *(small islet).

Set on the beach under the "Tree of Love", your union will be celebrated by the Master of Ceremony who will invite you to exchange your vows and wedding rings. To prolong this moment, a wedding cake and Champagne will be served while the smoothing song of the ukulele linger in the air. After the ceremony, you will proceed to cut the cake which represents the first act that the "Married Couple" do together....

Duration: approximately 15 minutes. Location: Under the Tree of Loue*. 99 300 XPF (832,13 Euros) par couple.

Included:

Bride's bouquet.

Groom's boutonnière.

Master of ceremonies

Liue Ukulele player or your music selection from a CD player.

Decoration of the uenue.

Marriage Certificate

Bottle of Champagne serued on the beach (75cl).

Wedding cake for two.

WESTERN STYLE CEREMONY HA'APUPURAA (Fusion of cultures)

Start this memorable morning by indulging in an ultimate Spa ritual. After the Spa, leisure time will be given for you to prepare for the ceremony.

By mid afternoon, the Ukulele player will escort you to the venue set on beach under the "Tree of Love", where your union will be celebrated by the Master of ceremony to the gentle sound of the Ukulele. To round out the ceremony, a refreshing cocktail will be served before the Ukulele player lead you back to your accommodation, where a Arii Turn Down await for you.

Duration: approximately 15 minutes.

Location: Under the Tree of Loue*.

195,500 XPF (1,638.29 Euros) per couple.

Included:

Ultimate Sparitual (3.20 hours).

Floral decoration at the wedding location.

Flower bouquet and boutonnière for the couple.

Master of ceremony.

Ukulele player (30 minutes)

Cocktail for two served in fresh coconut during the ceremony.


